A WALDORF-INSPIRED, CURATIVE EDUCATION

Through a Waldorf-inspired curriculum, students are immersed in main lesson subjects such as history, physics, math, and reading throughout the school year. These academic subjects are further enlivened through the curative arts of movement, painting, and handwork to engage the whole individual in an experience of the world. History and language come alive through the performing arts, music, and the spoken word, alongside life skills and employment exploration. These studies weave together and support our high school-aged students to step into the world with the curiosity and confidence to lead joyful and engaged lives. Over time, Raphael Academy students transition from adolescents to independent adults.
